1. What is the difference between All Remote Learning and Hybrid?

Ans: All Remote learning means students will attend all of their classes online and will not physically come to the school building and receive in-person instruction. Hybrid means students will receive both. On days they are virtual they will attend classes online and on in-person days they will attend school and receive in-person instruction in the classroom.

2. I want my child to be a hybrid student, what do I need to do?

Ans: You do not need to do anything. All students are assigned to Hybrid groups as a default. Unless you ask for all-remote learning you will remain in the system as a hybrid student. No submission is required.

3. Can a student switch between Hybrid and All Remote Learning? How often can a student switch?

Ans: Students are permitted to switch from Hybrid to All Remote Learning at any time. However to switch from All Remote Learning to Hybrid can only happen at the end of each Marking Period. There are specific scheduled dates when this can be completed.

4. How many days a student attends school if it is hybrid? How many hours?

Ans: Students who are Hybrid will report to school 2 days per week for a total of 8 hours (4 hours per day). Cohort A is Mondays & Thursdays and Cohort B is Tuesdays & Fridays. Wednesdays all are remote.

5. I don't have a login, what should I do?

Ans: If you do not know your username or password, please email to [ITHelp@pcsst.org](mailto:ITHelp@pcsst.org) from your email on file in the database.

We will verify your email address before sending information to you.

Please include the following in your email: Student First Name, Last Name, Grade

If your email address is different we will call you to confirm it before sending you information.

6. Who is supposed to sign up for an all remote learning program on behalf of the student?

Ans: Only the Primary Parent or Legal Guardian have access to the e-sign tab where all remote learning requests can be submitted.

7. I have not received an email for signing up for hybrid, why is it?

Ans: All students are assigned to Hybrid groups as a default. Unless you ask for all-remote learning you will remain in the system as a hybrid student. No submission is required.

8. How do I get my username and password for the database?

Ans: If you do not know your username or password, please email to [ITHelp@pcsst.org](mailto:ITHelp@pcsst.org) from your email on file in the database.

We will verify your email address before sending information to you.

Please include the following in your email: Student First Name, Last Name, Grade

If your email address is different we will call you to confirm it before sending you information.

9. How do I update my email address and phone number?

Ans: You should contact your campus secretary and give them your revised information.

10. If the number of covid 19 cases rises can we move students immediately from hybrid to online?

Ans: Yes you can. As per the executive order currently in effect, parents can request for all remote learning at any time.

11. When I sign up for All Remote Learning, it is giving me an option for 1st quarter. Do I have to sign up in every quarter? Is it for the entire year until school opens regularly?

Ans: Yes you need to submit for each quarter before the deadline. School will send reminders to parents to resubmit their all-remote requests in a timely manner.
