PCSST is excited to introduce our 2021-22 Tutoring Program for students who need extra academic support . **If your child has a failing grade of (F) in Mathematics, English, Science or Social Studies classes, we strongly recommend that you allow your child to take advantage of this great opportunity.** In this program, students will be afforded the opportunity to work on current content as well as basic skills.

This tutoring program is open to the students who failed one the four core subjects for the 1st marking period or are currently struggling in any of these classes. Students will be enrolled in the available sessions on a first-come, first-served basis. Parents may choose for their student to attend only one session or multiple sessions a week. **We ask that if you sign your child up for a seat in this program, that you ensure that your child attends regularly. If your child has multiple absences in the Tutoring Program, they may be dropped from the program in order to give that seat to another child waiting to join the program.**

The program will run from November 30, 2021 to January 27, 2022. The following tutoring sessions are available to your child:

Session 1: Tuesday-Thursday, 3:45pm-5:00pm

Session 2: Saturday, 8:30am-12:30pm
